GROUND RULES

CLASS REGISTRATION

Entries will close (2) classes prior to the class currently showing in arena. NO EXCEPIONS.

CLASS STARTS

Riders must be ready to enter the arena on time. (Be at the gate and ready to enter the arena before the class prior to yours ends.) There will not be any breaks in between classes. If there is to be a break or pause in between a class it must be at the request of the Chairman, Judge, or Steward.

(if there is a concern or problem that may grant a pause between classes please contact the Show Chairman)

COGGINS TEST

All horses must show proof of a current, negative EIA (Equine Infectious Anemia) test prior to entering the Fairgrounds. Any horse that can not show proof of a current negative EIA will not be permitted to enter the fair grounds and will be asked to leave the property.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES

All out of state horses must have a valid certificate of veterinary inspection prior to entering fairgrounds. Any horse that can not show a valid certificate of veterinary inspection will not be permitted to enter the fair grounds and will be asked to leave the property.

If you have any questions as to which vaccinations or papers are needed please contact your local Veterinarian.

ADMISSION

For each horse trailer / transportation vehicle entering the fairgrounds there will be only one free admission per horse trailer / transportation vehicle NO EXCEPTIONS!

If the rider or owner is not a passenger in the transportation vehicle they will be required to pay the regular show admission price for that day.

STALL RENTALS for barns A and B

All Stalls will be available on a first come first serve basis. If planning to stay for the full duration of the Horse show each stall needs to be reserved for each day needed.

Weekend blocks of stalls are available.

Stalls rented on a per day basis may not necessarily be available the next day.

Stall Bedding:

No Straw Allowed! Shavings Only! Shaving will be available for purchase at the fair grounds.

Stall Rules

Any horse occupying a stall that has not been reserved and paid for can and will be removed from that stall by a member of the Horse Show Staff. The individual or individuals responsible for that horse may be asked to leave the fair grounds without a refund.

Stall Rental for barn C (Draft Horse and Mule Barn)

Stall Bedding:

No Straw Allowed! Shavings Only! Shaving will be available for purchase at the fair grounds.

CONDUCT

Any act of discourtesy, unsportsmanlike conduct or mistreatment of any animal will result in the disqualification, forfeiture of all entries and prize money and you will be asked to leave the grounds.

Horses will be kept under control at all times. If for some reason a contestants horse becomes a problem or causes a disturbance, that is not stopped or controlled in a timely manner, a member of the horse show staff will step in and remove the problem horse from the area and assist the owner in getting the horse back to it's stall or back to it's trailer if need be. Individuals with uncontrollable horses may be asked to leave the grounds forfeiting any entry fee and prize money.

NO coolers or alcoholic beverages are allowed to be brought onto the fair grounds.

If a constant is traveling with an animal other than a horse that animal must be controlled at all times no exceptions! If the animal becomes a problem to contestants or audience members then the animal and owner will be asked to leave.
