Important Details of the Ride

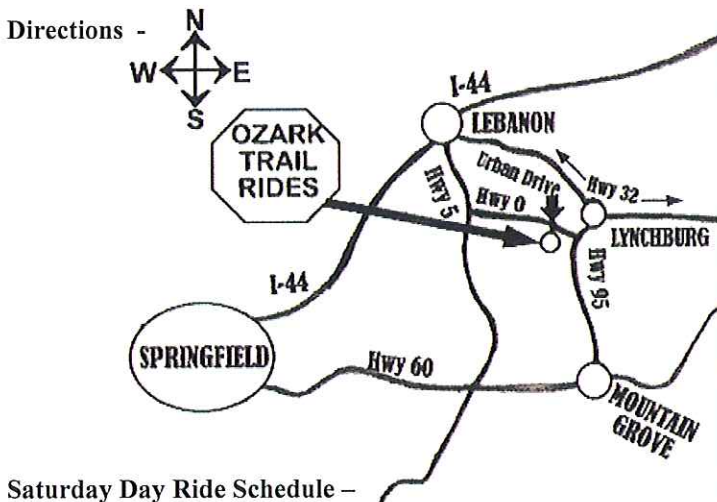
NO STALLIONS PLEASE!

Coggins – Negative coggins test at check-in.

Refunds – Granted if your cancellation is received two week prior to the ride.

1. Negative coggins test on all mounts.
2. No rough riding in camp or on trails.
3. No alcohol allowed while on the trail – upon return to camp, feel free to enjoy the drink of your choice.
4. No stallions without advanced permission.
5. We reserve the right to refuse any reservation.
6. All camps must be quiet by midnight.
7. Dogs are allowed in campsite only. Must be on a leash.
8. No ATV's, motorcycles, or bicycles allowed.
