Points go strictly to the rider. This is enforced by the "HONOR SYSTEM". This rule must be printed on the show bill.

It is Mandatory in all classes (<u>except: Hunt Seat and Timed events</u>) to wear Appropriate Western Attire, including long sleeves reaching the wrist and western hat. In all speed events hat and long sleeves are optional. Safety helmets shall be deemed appropriate attire.
