Academy Class Registration

Junior riders are required to wear protective headgear with chinstrap. Protective headgear is highly recommended for adult participants. Riders may not enter any other under-saddle class at this show. Lesson horses only (used regularly in a lesson program and not in training).

Pre-entering is available for Academy Division only. Classes 25-40 are <u>required</u> to pre-enter by noon on Tuesday, August 26, 2008. Failure to pre-enter will increase your entry fee to \$15. To pre-enter:

Stabling and Stabling Reservations

Stalls are available at the Horse Park by reservation only.

- Cost is \$50 per stall.
- Stall payment must be sent in with the stall request.
- Stalls will be assigned in the order received.
- Phone requests will be held for 5 days only.
- Stalls will be available from Friday afternoon to Sunday afternoon.
- First shavings are included, and additional shavings may be ordered when the stall reservation is made.

No straw is to be used for bedding and no hoses attached to the water faucets.
