

Show Attire

In all classes except English pleasure, horsemanship/ equitation, costume and game/speed events, western attire is required including short or long sleeve shirt (to the wrist) collared shirt, hat, and <u>BOOTS required</u>.

(Tank tops and halters are not allowed.)

For personal safety, it is recommended that protective helmets be used in speed events but not required.

HELMETS ARE ENCOURAGED FOR THE PEE WEE AND SPEED CLASSES.
