RULES AS SET BY CLUB

- 1. AQHA Rules will apply.
- 2. NOVICE riders will stay in the Novice Classes. If Novice rider advances to the next class they will <u>not</u> be able to go back down to Novice Class for the rest of the year.
- 3. NOVICE POLES and BARRELS will be TROT <u>only</u> if the trot is broken, it will be a "no time".
- 4. 17 & Under will be required to wear a helmet during speed courses.
- 5. If HOT, Judges decision to wear Western Short Sleeve Shirt with collar and buttons or snaps. Absolutely, no tanks or sleeveless shirts at any time. Boots required.
- 6. TRAIL CLASS will have (5) five obstacles and must back up somewhere in the obstacle course. There is a (2) two minute time limit on Trail Class. Only (3) three tries per obstacle. Then, you must move on to the next obstacle.
- 7. All PLEASURE and TRAIL CLASSES will be required to wear Western Attire Boots, Western Hats or Helmets. (Chaps are optional.)
- 8. BARRELS will be run in a cloverleaf pattern.
- 9. FLAGS will be run with (2) two barrels. Pick-up in (1) one barrel at one end and must be thrown in barrel at the other end. If not thrown in barrel no time will be given.
- 10. PLUG RACE will be run with (2) two barrels at one end of the arena. You must go around both barrels.
- 11. There will be no points given to the horse in the NOVICE CLASS. There will be a buckle given to the High Point Rider in the NOVICE CLASS.
- 12. There must be (4) four horses in a class or no payback will be given.
- 13. Payback percentage is up to each club to the amount given back in payback. If there is added money that is also up to each club for their shows.
- 14. Judges decisions are final!!!
- 15. There may be classes added at each show by club.

- PRIZE BUCKLES -

Buckles will be given for High Point Rider for Performance and Game 12 & Under; 13-17 years; High Point Horse; High Point Overall Rider; High Point Overall Novice Rider & High Point Leadline; Also for 18 & Over Rider and Horse

NOVICE is a rider who has not won in any open class or a rider who does not feel ready to move up and may have points in NOVICE CLASS.
