Entry fee will be \$20.00 per horse/rider combination. Additional horses/same rider combinations will be \$5.00 each. Members of the same family may exhibit the same horse, however each rider must pay the entry fee. Ribbons will be awarded to first five places in each class.

ASTM helmets are required for all speed events for riders 18 years and under. ASTM helmets are required for all hunt/english classes. Rider will be disqualified if helmet is not worn and properly fastened while in the arena in these classes.

Helmets can be worn in any class.

Proof of negative Coggins is required.

Novice riders may only compete in the novice division for the entire show. Novice riders may not lope/canter in any class and will be disqualified for doing so.

Halter classes (Class # 1 and 2) are judged on the horse's conformation and way of going.

Showmanship at Halter classes (3-6) are judged on the exhibitor's ability to show the horse in a pattern in hand.

Equitation and Horsemanship classes are judged on the rider's ability.

Pleasure classes are judged on the horse's way of going.
