## Rules and Regulations

Judge, ringmaster, or show organizers reserve the right to remove any horse and rider for unsporting or abusive behavior or dangerous behavior of the horse. Judge's decisions are final. No refunds.

Age Divisions—ALL rider ages are based on the age of the rider as of Jan. 1, 2010Youth: 8-13 yrsJr.: 14-18 yrsAdult: 19 yrs and older

Lead Line: is open to all riders ages 7 yrs and young as well as special needs riders of any age. May not cross into any other class. Handlers must be Jr. age or older.

Halter Classes: Horses of unknown breeding that do not fit the stock or gaited type should be entered in the Grade class. Ponies must be 56 inches or smaller.

Gaited Classes: Tack Optional. No band, pads or action devices-NO EXCEPTIONS!

Western Classes: Working tack & ranch attire encouraged. Long sleeves required. Helmets may be worn in lieu of cowboy hats. Stampede strings encouraged.

English Classes: Casual attire is encouraged. Helmets are required by all riders.
