- * A negative Coggins test, dated within one year, must be submitted with entry and must accompany each horse arriving on the grounds.
- * All dressage tests to be ridden in a plain snaffle, except Third Level or above, where full bridle is optional.
- * Beginner level test (walk only) e-mail for a copy of test
- * The 2007 USEF Dressage tests will be used for all classes except Intro classes, which will use 2007 USDF Introductory tests. USEF tests are available for download in PDF format from the web at

- * Informal attire (including jeans, paddock boots and half chaps) allowed. All jumping riders must wear hard hats.
- * Except where otherwise noted, USEF/USDF and MHSA rules will apply.
- * No braiding (unless you really want to).
- * No alcohol beverages on grounds
- * Dogs must be on leashes
