Conservative colored ASTM approved headgear is mandatory when mounted. Formal hunt attire may be worn without penalty. Spurs of the unrowelled type, crops, and bats are optional. Anyone not conforming to the dress code will not be considered an entry in the class. Showing, not to be judged, will be permitted.

<u>Classes 1-2.</u> Schooling Jumper: Open; 2'-2'3". Clean rounds return for a timed jump-off in 1st class. One timed round in 2nd class. <u>Classes 3-4. Training Jumper:</u> Open; fences 2'6"-2'9". Clean rounds return for a timed jump-off in first class. One timed round in 2nd class. <u>Classes 5-6. Open Jumper</u>: Open; fences 3'-3'3". Clean rounds return for a timed jump-off in first class. One timed round in 2nd class. <u>Classes 7-8</u> Warm up Hunter: Ride anytime during the Hunter divisions at the given heights for the various divisions. Will not reset jump heights until

<u>Class 7. Warm up Hunter</u>: Ride anytime during the Hunter divisions at the given heights for the various divisions. Will not reset jump heights until advancing to the next division. Not judged.

<u>Class 8. Pleasure Hunter Hack:</u> Manners and suitability for pleasure riding to be emphasized; may be asked to show on a loose rein. <u>Class 9. Bridle Path Hunter Hack</u>: Suitability for cross-country work emphasized; may be asked to lengthen trot and hand gallop (no more than 6

horses on the rail at a time for the gallop).

Class 10. Show Hunter Hack: Suitability for the show ring to be emphasized. Collection and lengthening of stride may be required.

<u>Classes 11-12. Ground Pole Equitation</u>: Children/Adult Amateur. Canter not required. Obstacles consist of four (4) poles on the ground, to be ridden once around the arena. Trot is not required in over-poles Class 11. Walk and trot are required in flat Class 12. If competing in this division, rider cannot jump higher than crossbars at the same show.

<u>Classes 13-15. Cross Bar Hunter:</u> Children/Adult Amateur. Walk/trot only in flat class. If competing in this division, horse/rider combination cannot jump higher than 2'3" at the same show.

Classes 16-17. Cross Bar Equitation: Children/Adult Amateur. Walk/trot only in flat class. If competing in this division, horse/rider combination cannot jump higher than 2'3" at the same show.

<u>Classes 18-20. Training Hunter</u>: Open. Fences 2'-2'3". If competing in this division, a horse/rider combination cannot jump 2'9" or higher at the same show.

<u>Classes 21-22. Beginner Equitation</u>: Children/Adult Amateur. Fences 2'to 2'3". If competing in this division, a rider cannot jump 2'6" or higher at the same show

Classes 23-25. Pony Hunter: Riders age 17 and under. Ponies 14.2 hands and under. Fences 2'-2'3"

Class 26. Leadline: Open to riders age 7 and under. Leadline required. Walk only. Horses in this class need not be registered with SMHJA. SMHJA dress code not enforced, but ASTM approved headgear and footwear with heel is mandatory. Riders cannot show in any other classes at the same show.

Classes 27-29. Non-Pro Hunter: Children/Adult Amateur. Fences 2'3"-2'6".

Classes 30-31. Intermediate Equitation: Children/Adult Amateur. Fences 2'3" to 2'6". If competing in this division, a rider cannot jump 3" or higher at the same show.

Classes 32-34. Low Working Hunter: Open. Fences 2'6" - 2'9"

Classes 35-37. Children's/AA Hunter: Children/Adult Amateur Fences 2'9" to 3'.

Classes 38-39. Children's/AA Equitation: Children/Adult Amateur Fences 2'9" to 3.

Classes 40-42. Working Hunter: Open. Open. Fences 3' to 3'3".

Adult Amateur - Riders 18 years old and over on January 1 of the current year and who do not engage in activities that would classify him/her as a professional per the current USEF Rule Book

Children -riders 17 years old and younger on December first of the previous year

From Springfield, Missouri: I-44 West to Exit 57 (Hwy 96 west to Avila). Hwy 96 West ~5 miles to Hwy M. Turn North (RIGHT) on Hwy M. then ~0.5 miles to 4th driveway on the right (at the bottom of the 2nd hill) - labrador retriever on mailbox.

From Carthage, Missouri: Hwy 96 East ~33 miles to Hwy M. Turn North (LEFT) on M Hwy..you will see M Hwy to the RIGHT approx 3 miles before you reach M Hwy that turns LEFT...stay on 96 until M turns to your LEFT.
