AMATEUR: A person 18 years of age or older as of January 1 of the then current show year who does not accept money for riding or training.

BEST OF SHOW: First place winners of classes 7-22 may participate in the Best of Show class. Horses will not be ridden more than 10 minutes.

MFTHBA Rules Apply

Classes open to all GAITED type horses.

- •Helmets are required for all youth in timed event classes.
- Judges at their discretion, may adjust the rules for attire due to weather conditions.
- •Membership fee: \$25 per family or \$15 for individual
- Nomination Fee: 1st horse is \$10 and each additional horse is \$5
- •Horse must be nominated, rider must be a member and show in 50% plus 1 of the shows to qualify for year end awards.
- •Membership is not required to show with Sho-Me Horse Show
- •Horses do not have to be registered to show with Sho-Me Horse Show Association.
