NOVICE: Only persons who have not won a 1st place year end award for a performance class in ANY stock horse association in the past 2 years are eligible to compete in a novice class.

PONIES: Ponies under 56" may enter designated "pony" classes only. Riders must be the appropriate size for the pony.

<u>ATTIRE</u>: For halter, western riding and timed classes, appropriate western attire includes a long sleeved shirt, western hat (or helmet) and western boots.

Spurs and chaps are optional. Hats or (helmets) must be on as you enter the arena English classes: Appropriate attire includs helmet, hunt coat, breaches, and boots as well as a tie or choker. Gloves and unrowelled spurs are optional.

AQHA Rules Apply

Classes open to all STOCK type horses.

- •Helmets are required for all youth in timed event classes.
- Judges at their discretion, may adjust the rules for attire due to weather conditions
- Membership: \$25 per family or \$15 per individual
- •Nomination fee: 1st horse is \$10 and each additional horse is \$5
- Horse must be nominated, rider must be a member and show in 50% plus 1 of the shows to qualify for year end awards.
- •Membership is not required and horse does not have to be registered to show.
