### Schooling

Schooling is available Saturday after 4:00pm. **We ask that no one arrive at TH prior to 4:00pm on Saturday.** Sunday schooling will available in Ring 1 until 9:30am and in Ring 2 following Class 8. All horses on the property must be checked in at the show office. Any horse not showing must pay a non-showing fee and a grounds fee before schooling.
