- **LOCATION: Ste. Genevieve County Fairgrounds**
- I-55 South to East on Hwy 32 (becomes 4th St.), continue and follow signs to fairgrounds.
- Alternative route; get off Hwy 55 Junc. O to Hwy 61 stay on it 5.7 miles, turn Left on Industrial River road. Follow signs to fairgrounds.
- 4-H Concessions on grounds.

- Rules posted at entry booth.
- Suitable attire required in all classes.
- Must show 4 of the 6-point shows to be eligible for high point awards.

- Hats required in all classes except speed.
- Helmet required in all youth classes ages 10 & under
- Hitting the horse in front of the saddle is a disqualification
- *Gaited horses – No pad, open frog, legal plantation shoes
- *Jackpot Barrels – Class # 26, \$12 entry fee, no trophy or year-end awards given, 90% payout, 3 places
- Lite shod classes must have ½ - ¾ show size.
- Exhibitors under 18 years MUST have a parent or responsible party sign for them (DOB as of Jan. 1, 2013)
- Boots with defined heels are required for all riding classes.
- Class ages are as of January 1, 2013
- You MUST be 16 years of age to handle a stallion.
- Palming the barrel is a disqualification
- Speed horses MUST enter and exit the ring under control and NO RUNNING.
