# Rules and Regulations

## **AGE:**

Riders must be 8 years of age or older on January 1, 2016 to compete in this horse show in any division except Leadline 7 & Under, Walk-Whoa 7 & Under, and Stick horse 5 & Under.

**Walk-Whoa:** We will offer three "Walk-Whoa" classes for children under the age of 7 and just beginning to show. These classes will be eligible for high-point awards. They will not be eligible for the saddle raffle.

## **AWARDS:**

**Ribbons:** awarded to 1st through 10th Place in each class

**Belt Buckles:** awarded to the High Point in each division. *See High Points below.*

**Entry Fees:** \$15 per class    Jackpot Entry Fees: \$25 per class

**Entry Deadline:** August 20, 2016

**Late Entries:** accepted day of show with late fee of \$30 per horse. Exhibitors may enter additional classes on horses that are pre entered at no additional charge.

*12 Month Negative Coggins and 30 day Health Certificate required for each horse.*

## **YOUTH ADULT WESTERN PLEASURE CHALLENGE:**

Adult to show the horse at a walk, trot and canter one direction and line up in the center. Switch to youth rider in the center of the arena (maximum of 3 minutes allowed for tack change if needed) and youth rider to show the horse at a walk, trot and canter the second direction, line up and back the horse.

**Trophy Saddle Raffle:** The American Royal will raffle a custom American Royal saddle, *sponsored by the Dillingham Family*. For every class entry, one raffle ticket will be given. The raffle will take place at the end of the show on Sunday evening.
