1. STOCK Type Mare/Gelding & Pony Model Halter –Mares, Geldings & ponies will be judged separate
2. NON-STOCK Type Mare, Gelding & Pony-Mares, Gelding & ponies will be judged separate
3. LEADLINE-riders 10 yrs. & under-Rider cannot enter into any other class
4. BEGINNER WALK-11 yrs. & under-pony or horse-RIDER CAN ENTER INTO CLASS#11, Plus see note below
5. SENIOR ENGLISH-Walk/Trot-18 yrs, & older
6. SENIOR ENGLISH Pleasure-Walk/Trot/Canter-18 yr. & older
7. OPEN GAITED Breed Country Pleasure-Walk & Favorite Gait-Western or English
8. YOUTH ENGLISH -Walk/Trot-17 yrs. & under
9. YOUTH ENGLISH Pleasure-Walk/Trot/Canter-17 yrs. & under-no ponies under 52”
- 10.OPEN GAITED 2 Gait Pleasure –Walk & Favorite Gait-Western or English

- 24.VERSATILITY FUN Class-ALL AGES-Western or English-different class @ each show-see description @ desk
- 25.TRAINING POLES-may run 2 times only per horse-\$5.00 per run-no ribbons-no awards points
- 26.YOUTH POLES-17 yrs. & under (no leading in this class)
- 27.ADULTS POLES-18 yr. & over (no leading in this class)
- 28.TRAINING BARRELS-may run 2 times only per horse-\$5.00 per run-no ribbons-no awards points
- 29.YOUTH BARRELS-17 yrs. & under (no leading in this class)
- 30.ADULT BARRELS-18 yrs. & older (no leading in this class)

PLEASE OBSERVE PROPER ATTIRE FOR ALL CLASSES; NO T-SHIRTS, BALL CAPS OR TENNIS SHOES. Must have a COLLARED SHIRT in all classes. -Judge’s decision final. *Model Halter classes may use a halter or bridle- all entries enter arena single file & line up to be judged on CONFORMATION only. *Beginners may enter Halter & Fun (if fun class is a 1 on 1 class) & Training classes only –Beginner’s may have helper in arena but must not interfere with rider or judge-NO Big Lick Padded Shoes, Chains or action devices allowed. Plantation shoes are allowed. Snaffle bit rides 2 handed, Shank bit rides 1 handed.

Beginner class explanations:

Beginner Walk – This class will be for children 11 years and under on stock or NON-stock horses, ponies, mules, or donkeys. Children will enter at a walk and the announcer will call the gaits. NO BACK UPS in this class. The class will be judged to 6 place ribbons. Parents &/or guardians may enter the ring if they desire but must not lead the horse or interfere with the judge's line of sight. Children SHOULD wear a helmet but it is up to the parent or guardian. This class is designed for children who are “graduating” from lead line and just starting their show career. Riders may enter halter classes & speed classes plus a fun class if it is a one on one fun class if they can control their horses.

Beginner Walk / Trot (or favorite gait) – This class will be for children 11 years and under on stock or NON-stock horses, ponies, mules, or donkeys. Children will enter at a walk and the announcer will call the gaits. NO BACK UPS in this class. The class will be judged to 6 place ribbons. Parents &/or Guardians may enter the ring if they desire but must not lead the horse or interfere with the judge's line of sight. Children SHOULD wear a helmet but it is up to the parent or guardian. This class is designed for children who are “graduating” from lead line and just starting their show career and who are able to handle their equine at the next gait above a walk. Riders may enter halter & speed classes plus fun class if it a one on one class if they are able to control their horses

RANCH RIDING CLASSES DESCRIPTION

This class is a class as if you were riding &/or /herding on the western plains using an all natural way of going for both horse and rider.....

This class shows the horse's ability to move at a working speed with a rider. Horses will be shown at three (3) gaits-walk, trot, canter in each direction of the arena. Horses will also be asked to reverse away from the rail, to stop and back. The judge may ask for an extended trot and extended canter at least one direction of the ring. A horse will be given credit for traveling with his head held in a normal position, ears alert and moving at a natural speed for the gait requested. Credit will also be given for making a smooth transition between the gaits, for keeping the correct lead, and for maintaining the gait requested until the judge requests a change. A rider must show his horse with only one (1) hand on the reins, unless the horse is 4 years old or younger and is being shown in a snaffle bit or hackamore (bosal). Finalist may be worked individually at the discretion of the judge. Judges are encouraged to work exhibitors thoroughly, if time permits.

Fancy tack and dress is not required for this class.

Snaffle bit or hackamore(bosal) with 2 hands up to 4 years old or younger

Shank bit with 1 hand 5 years or older.

This class was put into the show for the people that could not ride &/or place in the western pleasure classes with their horses because they are not western pleasure type horses.

NEC WILL CHARGE YOU AN ADDITIONAL STALL FEE OF \$25.00 IF YOU COME IN BEFORE 4:30 ON Friday...

All stalls must be paid for upon arrival & Coggins papers checked @ arena "B" office before unloading.

HORSE stalls will be assigned, DO NOT change stalls, if there is a problem come to arena "B" office

Additional bags of shavings may be purchased for \$8.64 per bag, ordered @ arena "B" office

GROUPS

TACK stalls will be assigned-do not put a horse in the tack stall. (if you do, you will be charged a horse stall fee) no shavings in tack stalls

Only one person in the group will be charged for the group tack stall or stalls on their entry form, group must pay that person, we will not split fees on tack stalls

If you want to be in group, all horses & tack stalls must be assigned at the same time. Sally will need the names of each person in the group in order to assign stalls,
